DIRECTIONS TO FOREST GATE FARM -Leave the M6 at junction 19, taking the A556 towards Chester. Turn right onto the B5152 at Abbey Arms Pub. Continue along this road, passing through Delamere Forest. Once you have passed The Carriers Inn and Hatchmere Lake on your left take the next turning on your right into Forest Lane. Forest Gate Farm is the first property on the left.

Please note some parking may be on the field opposite the drive, stewards will direct you accordingly. Parking is limited so please park considerately. Please ensure you clear up any droppings left by your horse.
