**Beginners classes:** combination of horse and rider to have never won a ODE at any level, otherwise as per for novice classes

**Novice Classes:** Combination of horse and rider not to have won any ODE competition (other than a beginners) and not to have completed a Riding Club or Pony Club open horse trials or any BE horse trials, including **BE80(T)**.

**Open Novice Classes:** Are for horse and rider combinations who are unable to meet the above restriction but do not want to compete at the Intermediate height.

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

### Flu vaccination policy

DFRC wish to behave responsibly to the welfare of all horses. It will be necessary to have a fully correct course of Flu injections to compete at this event. All horses competing must be fully vaccinated and had their last booster within 12 months of the event, but not in the preceding 7 days. Spot checks will be undertaken.

Neither **Delamere Forest Riding Club**, its committee nor any persons acting on its behalf, accept any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to any person, animal or property whatsoever from whatever cause.

Save for death or serious injury caused by the negligence of the organiser or DFRC, neither the organiser or DFRC Committee, nor any agent, employee or representative accept any liability for accidents, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.

### Protective Headgear

‘Protective Headwear’ must be worn at all times by anyone, whether or not a competitor, riding anywhere at a BRC event. Harnesses must be correctly adjusted and fastened.

‘Protective Headwear’ constitutes a hat which meets one of the current standards as detailed in the BRC 2021 Rule Book, failure to do so will incur elimination.

- PAS 015 (1998 or 2011) AND BSI Kitemark or Inspec IC Mark
- VG1 01.040 (2014-12) AND BSI Kitemark or Inspec IC Mark
- ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a onwards) AND SEI mark
- SNELL E2001/2016 AND Official SNELL label and number
- AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards) AND SAI Global mark

Only a "Jockey Skull" of an even round or elliptical shape with a smooth or slightly abrasive surface, having no peak or peak type extensions may be worn for any XC phase. Noticeable protuberances above the eyes or to the front, not greater than 5mm, smooth and rounded in nature are permitted. It must also comply with the 'Protective Headwear' criteria and be tagged as set out above. A removable hat cover with a light flexible peak may be used. The use of **HEAD CAMS are strictly prohibited** at any BRC affiliated competition. This includes use on the head, chest, bridle or any other part of the horse or rider.

The wearing of a BETA 2009/2018 Level 3 body protector is compulsory. **(Body Protectors with the 2000 label are no longer acceptable).**

British riding club rules apply in all other situations. Acceptance of the rules is a condition of entry. DFRC health & safety policy should be adhered to. Copies are available on request. Full DFRC event rules can be found at [dfrc.co.uk](http://dfrc.co.uk)

Stallions are not allowed at any DFRC event

**Please be advised that photography will be taking place at this event.**

#### **PLEASE NOTE**

**Competitors eliminated in the show jumping, other than for error of course, will not be allowed to start on the cross country phase**

**Refunds will not be made for withdrawals after the closing date unless the space can be filled in which case a £10 admin fee will be retained. Withdrawals made before the closing date will be subject to a £5 admin fee.**

**Should the event be cancelled, a £10 abandonment fee will be retained**

**All dogs to be on lead - £10 recovery fee for those found wandering.**

Schooling at Smallwood should not be undertaken within 7 days of the event

#### **DIRECTIONS TO SMALLWOOD**

Leave the M6 at junction 17 taking the A534 towards Congleton. Carry straight on over the traffic lights. Approximately 1 mile further along the Congleton Road, turn right into Brookhouse Lane and follow this road for a further mile. Smallwood is on this road. Riding Club Signs will be positioned on route.
